## Employment Network - Immediate Skills We Require

### Mechanics

We still have unprecedented demand for mechanics. Of the new members we have signed up they require over 30 between them and the list is growing. ### Fixed Plant Fitters

We have not seen any real demand in this area as of yet. There still seems to be enough in the Australian workforce to fill these vacancies. These jobs will be mining related when they occur so you will need experience in hoppers, conveyors, crushers, cones etc. Basically any machinery that would be used on a mining or similar type site.

### Metal Fabricators

We are meeting with a client next week who informs us they will need 100 boilermakers over the next 12 months and they do not believe that they can fill all of these positions from the Australian job seeker pool. They will be looking for welders with experience in heavy plate, repairs to mining equipment such as hoppers and crushers etc. as mentioned above. We have had no enquiries for Sheet Metal workers at this stage in time. We also have a client in Mackay who wants fabricators experienced in metal landings, stairs and handrails.

### 6G Welders

Still no demand in this area but hang in there because it will happen as Gladstone and the Gorgon project in WA gear up.

### Engineers/Quantity Surveyors/ Architects/Project Managers

We still have good demand for engineers with a minimum of 2 years experience in the areas of infrastructure, services, roads, bridges, petro chemical, mine sites etc. Interviews for suitable candidates are happening now!

### Fitters & Turners (CNC Operators)

We are getting some enquiry for both CNC operators with a metal industry background & experienced fitters & turners with good manual skills in these areas. Once again the work is all mining related so we are looking for skills in shafts, gear boxes, hydraulic rams, transmissions, sleeves & pumps.

### Sales Coordinators

Our client is still looking for these. They have already made offers to 3 persons fitting this job description and are looking for more. If you or your friends have 5 years in an industrial sales environment and have a basic understanding of equipment hire we have attractive packages on offer. ## Visa Requirement Changes

Changes to English requirements earlier this year have made it easier for some 457 applicants to prove their English ability. Where the applicant has completed at least 5 consecutive years of fulltime study at secondary or higher level, where the instruction was delivered in English, this is now sufficient to show English language ability without undertaking an IELTS test. Canadian, US, UK, NZ and Irish passport holders continue to be exempt from the need to prove English ability.

If you have recently received an email from us asking for you to submit skills summaries & employee agreements and have not responded you will not be eligible to be submitted to our clients for interviews. So hurry and submit these if you want the opportunity to move to Australia and start working.
